3 SECTION 1. SANTA CRUZ ISLAND; ADDITIONAL RIGHTS OF 4

USE AND OCCUPANCY.

5 Section 202(e) of Public Law 96–199 (16 U.S.C.

410ff-1(e)) is amended by adding the following at the end 6 7 thereof:

1 "(5) In the case of the real property referred to in 2 paragraph (1), in addition to the rights of use and occu-3 pancy reserved under paragraph (1) and set forth in In-4 strument 90–027494, upon the enactment of this para-5 graph, the Secretary shall grant identical rights of use and occupancy to Mr. Francis Gherini of Ventura, California, 6 7 the previous owner of the real property, and to each of 8 the two grantors identified in Instrument No. 92–102117 9 recorded in the Official Records of the County of Santa 10 Barbara, California. The use and occupancy rights granted to Mr. Francis Gherini shall be for a term of 25 years 11 12 from the date of the enactment of this paragraph. The 13 Secretary shall grant such rights without consideration 14 and shall execute and record such instruments as nec-15 essary to vest such rights in such individuals as promptly as practicable, but no later than 90 days, after the enact-16 ment of this paragraph.". 17
