- 3 SECTION 1. PURPOSE.
- 4 The purpose of this Act is to assist individuals and
- 5 local, State, and Federal agencies in complying with the
- 6 Endangered Species Act of 1973 in reconstructing or re-
- 7 pairing of flood control levee structures to address immi-
- 8 nent threats to public health or safety or catastrophic nat-

3	SEC. 2. AMENDMENTS TO ENDANGERED SPECIES ACT OF
4	1973.
5	(a) Actions Exempt From Consultation and
6	Conferencing.—Section 7(a) of the Endangered Species
7	Act of 1973 (16 U.S.C. 1536(a)) is amended by adding
8	at the end the following new paragraph:
9	"(5) Consultation and conferencing under paragraphs
10	(2) and (4) is not required for any agency action that—
11	"(A) consists of reconstruction or repair of a
12	Federal or non-Federal levee structure—
13	"(i) to address a critical, imminent threat
14	to public health or safety; or
15	"(ii) to address a catastrophic natural
16	event; or
17	"(B) consists of maintaining the structural in-
18	tegrity of a Federal or non-Federal levee structure.".
19	(b) Exclusion From Takings Prohibition.—Sec-
20	tion 9(a) of such Act (16 U.S.C. 1538(a)) is amended by
21	adding at the end the following new paragraph:
22	"(3) For purposes of this subsection, an activity of
23	a Federal or non-Federal person is not a taking of a spe-
24	cies if the activity—

2	Federal or non-Federal levee structure—
3	"(i) to address a critical, imminent threat
4	to public health or safety; or
5	"(ii) to address a catastrophic natural
6	event; or
7	"(B) consists of maintaining the structural in-
8	tegrity of a Federal or non-Federal levee structure.".

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
