#### **3** SECTION 1. REFUNDS.

4 (a) AMENDMENT.—The Natural Gas Policy Act of

5 1978 (15 U.S.C. 3301 et seq.) is amended by adding at

6 the end the following new section:

### 7 "SEC. 603. REFUNDS.

8 "In the event any refunds of any rates and charges9 made, demanded, or received for reimbursement of State

ad valorem taxes in connection with the sale of natural 1 gas prior to 1989 are ordered to be made by the Commis-2 sion, the refunds shall be ordered to be made without in-3 4 terest or penalty of any kind, and the refunds shall be 5 required only to the extent that the purchaser dem-6 onstrates to the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission that the refund will be passed on to ultimate consumers 7 of the natural gas.". 8

9 (b) TABLE OF CONTENTS AMENDMENT.—The table
10 of contents of the Natural Gas Policy Act of 1978 is
11 amended by adding at the end the following new item: "Sec. 603. Refunds.".
