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## A BILL

To exclude grants for student financial assistance from the prohibition on certain departments and agencies of the Government making grants to institutions of higher education that prevent ROTC access to campus or military recruiting on campus.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. GRANTS FOR STUDENT AID EXCEPTED FROM**  
2 **PROHIBITIONS ON FEDERAL GRANTS TO IN-**  
3 **STITUTIONS OF HIGHER EDUCATION THAT**  
4 **PREVENT ROTC ACCESS TO CAMPUS OR MILI-**  
5 **TARY RECRUITING ON CAMPUS.**

6 (a) DEPARTMENTS OF EDUCATION, LABOR, AND  
7 HEALTH AND HUMAN SERVICES.—Section 514 of the De-  
8 partments of Labor, Health and Human Services, and  
9 Education, and Related Agencies Appropriations Act,  
10 1997 (as contained in section 101(e) of division A of Pub-  
11 lic Law 104–208; 110 Stat. 3009–270; 10 U.S.C. 503  
12 note), is amended by striking “by grant (including a grant  
13 of funds to be available for student aid) to a covered edu-  
14 cational entity” in subsections (a) and (b) and inserting  
15 “by grant to a covered educational entity, other than a  
16 grant of funds to a covered educational entity to be avail-  
17 able solely for student financial assistance or related ad-  
18 ministrative costs,”.

19 (b) DEPARTMENT OF DEFENSE.—(1) Section 983 of  
20 title 10, United States Code, is amended—

21 (A) by striking “No funds” and all that follows  
22 through “student aid)” and inserting “Except as  
23 provided in paragraph (3), no funds appropriated or  
24 otherwise available to the Department of Defense  
25 may be obligated by contract or by grant”; and

1           (B) by adding at the end the following new  
2       paragraph:

3       “(3) Paragraph (1) does not apply with respect to  
4       grants to be available solely for student financial assist-  
5       ance or related administrative costs.”.

6       (2) Section 558(a) of the National Defense Author-  
7       ization Act for Fiscal Year 1995 (10 U.S.C. 503 note)  
8       is amended—

9           (A) by striking “No funds” in paragraph (1)  
10       and inserting “Except as provided in paragraph (3),  
11       no funds”; and

12       (B) by adding at the end the following new  
13       paragraph:

14       “(3) Paragraph (1) does not apply with respect to  
15       grants to be available solely for student financial assist-  
16       ance or related administrative costs.”.

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
