- 3 SECTION 1. AUTHORITY TO INCLUDE COSTS OF TRAINING
- 4 OF PSYCHOLOGISTS IN PAYMENTS TO HOS-
- 5 PITALS UNDER MEDICARE.
- 6 Effective for cost reporting periods beginning on or
- 7 after October 1, 1999, for purposes of payments to hos-
- 8 pitals under the Medicare Program under title XVIII of

- 1 the Social Security Act for costs of approved educational
- 2 activities (as defined in section 413.85 of title 42 of the
- 3 Code of Federal Regulations), such approved educational
- 4 activities shall include professional educational training
- 5 programs, recognized by the Secretary, for psychologists.
