## A BILL

To amend title 38, United States Code, to authorize the Secretary of Veterans Affairs to furnish headstones or markers for the marked graves of certain individuals.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. INCLUSION OF MARKED GRAVES AS ELIGIBLE
- 4 GRAVES FOR DEPARTMENT FURNISHED
- 5 HEADSTONES OR MARKERS.
- 6 (a) In General.—Section 2306 of title 38, United
- 7 States Code, is amended in subsection (a), by striking out
- 8 "unmarked".

- 1 (b) Previously Marked Graves Ineligible.—
- 2 Section 2306 of such title is amended by adding at the
- 3 end the following new subsection:
- 4 "(f)(1) In the case of the grave of an individual de-
- 5 scribed in subsection (a) that is marked before January
- 6 1, 2000, with a headstone or marker, the person entitled
- 7 under subsection (a) to request a headstone or marker for
- 8 such individual may receive from the Secretary such head-
- 9 stone or marker.
- 10 "(2) The Secretary may only furnish the headstone
- 11 or marker under paragraph (1) at no cost to the United
- 12 States.".
- 13 (c) Effective Date.—The amendments made
- 14 under this section shall take effect on January 1, 2000.
