Mr. WYNN introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on Small Business

A BILL

To amend the Small Business Act to provide a penalty for the failure by a Federal contractor to subcontract with small businesses as described in its subcontracting plan, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Subcontractor Protec-
5 tion Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. IMPLEMENTATION OF SUBCONTRACTING PLANS.**

2 Section 8(d) of the Small Business Act (15 U.S.C.
3 637(d)) is amended by adding at the end the following
4 new paragraphs:

5 “(12) In the case of any contract containing a sub-
6 contracting plan included pursuant to paragraph (4) or
7 (5), the following provisions apply:

8 “(A) The executive agency awarding the con-
9 tract shall include in the contract a clause providing
10 for the withholding of not less than (i) \$5,000 in the
11 case of a contract in the amount of \$100,000 or
12 less, (ii) 3 percent of the contract amount in the
13 case of a contract in an amount of more than
14 \$100,000 and less than \$5,000,000, and (iii) 5 per-
15 cent of the contract amount in the case of a contract
16 in an amount of \$5,000,000 or more, if the con-
17 tractor does not achieve the percentage goal for the
18 utilization of small business concerns owned and
19 controlled by socially and economically disadvan-
20 tagged individuals as set forth in the subcontracting
21 plan.

22 “(B) The executive agency awarding the con-
23 tract shall require the contractor to provide written
24 justification to the agency whenever the contractor,
25 in performing the contract, does not enter into a
26 subcontract with, or substitutes another subcon-

1 tractor for, a specific small business identified in the
 2 subcontracting plan.

3 “(13) The Administration shall establish a telephone
 4 line or other electronic means of communication through
 5 which any small business identified in a subcontracting
 6 plan by an offeror or bidder may communicate to the Ad-
 7 ministration any concerns regarding major deviations by
 8 prime contractors from the use of small businesses as sub-
 9 contractors under the prime contract as described in sub-
 10 contracting plans.”.

11 **SEC. 3. REQUIREMENT TO CONSIDER USE OF SMALL BUSI-**
 12 **NESS CONCERNS OWNED AND CONTROLLED**
 13 **BY SOCIALLY AND ECONOMICALLY DIS-**
 14 **ADVANTAGED INDIVIDUALS WHEN CONSID-**
 15 **ERING PAST COMPLIANCE WITH SUBCON-**
 16 **TRACTING PLANS.**

17 Section 8(d) of the Small Business Act (15 U.S.C.
 18 637(d)) is amended in the second sentence of paragraphs
 19 (4)(C) and (5)(B) by inserting after “other such subcon-
 20 tracting plans” each place it appears the following:
 21 “, especially compliance with the goal set forth in such
 22 plans for the utilization of small business concerns owned
 23 and controlled by socially and economically disadvantaged
 24 individuals,”.

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
