3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Volunteer Firefighter
- 5 Equipment Enhancement Act of 1999".

1SEC. 2. EXPANSION OF EQUIPMENT OF VOLUNTEER FIRE2DEPARTMENTS ELIGIBLE FOR TAX-EXEMPT3FINANCING.

4 (a) IN GENERAL.—Subparagraph (B) of section
5 150(e)(1) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 (relating
6 to bonds of certain volunteer fire departments) is amended
7 by striking "or firetruck" and inserting "firetruck, ambu8 lance, or other emergency response vehicle".

9 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made by
10 subsection (a) shall apply to bonds issued after the date
11 of the enactment of this Act.

12 SEC. 3. TREATMENT OF EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICE 13 ORGANIZATIONS UNDER TAX-EXEMPT BONDS 14 BULES.

(a) IN GENERAL.—Subsection (e) of section 150 of
the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 is amended by redesignating paragraph (3) as paragraph (4) and by inserting
after paragraph (2) the following new paragraph:

19 "(3) COMPARABLE TREATMENT FOR VOLUN20 TEER EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICE ORGANIZA21 TIONS.—

22 "(A) IN GENERAL.—An organization which
23 provides volunteer emergency medical services
24 shall be treated for purposes of this subsection
25 as if—

1	"(i) such organization were a volun-
2	teer fire department, and
3	"(ii) such services were firefighting
4	services.
5	"(B) Special rule.—For purposes of ap-
6	plying this subsection to an organization de-
7	scribed in subparagraph (A) which does not
8	provide firefighting services, paragraph $(2)(A)$
9	shall be applied by substituting 'other emer-
10	gency medical services' for 'other firefighting
11	services'."
12	(b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made by
13	subsection (a) shall apply to bonds issued after the date
14	of the enactment of this Act.

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
