4	(a) Additions to National Estuary Program.—
5	Section 320(a)(2)(B) of the Federal Water Pollution Con-
6	trol Act (33 U.S.C. 1330(a)(2)(B)) is amended by insert-
7	ing "Lake Ponchartrain Basin, Louisiana and Mississippi;
8	Mississippi Sound, Mississippi;" before "and Peconic Bay,
9	New York.".
10	(b) Grants.—Section 320(g) of the Federal Water
11	Pollution Control Act (33 U.S.C. 1330(g)) is amended by
12	striking paragraphs (2) and (3) and inserting the fol-
13	lowing:
14	"(2) Purposes.—Grants under this subsection
15	shall be made to pay for activities necessary for the
16	development and implementation of a comprehensive
17	conservation and management plan under this sec-
18	tion.
19	"(3) Federal share.—The Federal share of a
20	grant to any person (including a State, interstate, or
21	regional agency or entity) under this subsection for
22	a fiscal year—
23	"(A) shall not exceed—
24	"(i) 75 percent of the annual aggre-
25	gate costs of the development of a com-

3	"(ii) 50 percent of the annual aggre-		
4	gate costs of the implementation of the		
5	plan; and		
6	"(B) shall be made on condition that the		
7	non-Federal share of the costs are provided		
8	from non-Federal sources.".		
9	(c) Authorization of Appropriations.—Section		
10	320(i) of the Federal Water Pollution Control Act (33		
11	U.S.C. 1330(i)) is amended by striking "\$12,000,000 per		
12	fiscal year for each of fiscal years 1987, 1988, 1989,		
13	1990, and 1991" and inserting "\$50,000,000 for each of		
14	fiscal years 2000 through 2004".
