A BILL

To provide for the continued maintenance and preservation of Governors Island, New York, by the Administrator of General Services.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Governors Island Pres-
5 ervation Act of 1999”.

1 **SEC. 2. CONTINUED MAINTENANCE AND PRESERVATION OF**
2 **GOVERNORS ISLAND, NEW YORK, BY THE AD-**
3 **MINISTRATOR OF GENERAL SERVICES.**

4 (a) REPEAL OF DISPOSAL REQUIREMENT.—The
5 Balanced Budget Act of 1997 is amended by striking sec-
6 tion 9101 (111 Stat. 670).

7 (b) AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.—There
8 are authorized to be appropriated to the Administrator of
9 General Services for maintenance and preservation of Gov-
10 ernors Island, New York, including buildings and other
11 improvements on the island, such sums as may be nec-
12 essary for fiscal year 2000 and each fiscal year thereafter.
