9 (a) CONTRIBUTIONS TO INTERNATIONAL ORGANIZA10 TIONS.—In title IV of the Departments of Commerce, Jus-

tice, and State, the Judiciary, and Related Agencies Ap propriations Act, 1998 (Public Law 105–119), under the
heading "Contributions to International Organizations",
the first and second provisos shall not apply.

5 (b) CONTRIBUTIONS FOR INTERNATIONAL PEACE-KEEPING ACTIVITIES.—In title IV of the Departments of 6 7 Commerce, Justice, and State, the Judiciary, and Related 8 Agencies Appropriations Act, 1998 (Public Law 105– 9 119), under the heading "Contributions for International 10 Peacekeeping Activities", the first proviso shall not apply. 11 SEC. 3. AVAILABILITY OF FISCAL YEAR 1999 FUNDS FOR AR-12 **REARAGES TO INTERNATIONAL ORGANIZA-**13 TIONS AND CONFERENCES.

14 Pursuant to the first proviso under the heading "Ar-15 rearage Payments" in title IV of the Commerce, Justice, and State, the Judiciary, and Related Agencies Appropria-16 tions Act, 1999 (as contained in section 101(b) of division 17 A of the Omnibus Consolidated and Emergency Supple-18 mental Appropriations Act, 1999; Public Law 105–277), 19 the obligation and expenditure of funds appropriated 20 21 under such heading for payment of arrearages to meet ob-22 ligations of membership in the United Nations, and to pay 23 assessed expenses of international peacekeeping activities

- 2 heading shall not apply.
