A BILL

To specify that the legal public holiday known as
Washington's Birthday be called by the name.

- 1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
- 2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*
- 3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**
- 4 This Act may be cited as the “George Washington,
- 5 Bicentennial Act of 1999”.

1 **SEC. 2. DESIGNATION OF WASHINGTON'S BIRTHDAY.**

2 The legal public holiday known as “Washington’s
3 Birthday” as specified in section 6103 of title 5, United
4 States Code, shall be referred to by that name and no
5 other—

6 (1) by all entities and officials of the United
7 States Government; and
8 (2) whenever it appears in any federally funded
9 publications.
