3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

4 This Act may be cited as the "Veterans' Equity Act5 of 1997".

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1 SEC. 2. EXCLUSION FROM INCOME.

2 Notwithstanding section 3 of the United States 3 Housing Act of 1937, for purposes of determining the 4 amount of rent paid by a family for occupancy of a public 5 housing dwelling unit or a dwelling unit assisted under 6 section 8 of such Act, the adjusted income of a family shall 7 not be considered to include any amounts received by the 8 family from the Secretary of Veterans Affairs as—

9 (1) compensation, as defined in section 101(13)
10 of title 38, United States Code;

(2) dependency and indemnity compensation, as
defined in section 101(14) of such title; or

13 (3) pension, as defined in section 101(15) of14 such title.

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
