## A BILL

To amend the Higher Education Act of 1965 to recognize the time required to save funds for the college education of adopted children.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. TREATMENT OF ADOPTED CHILDREN IN NEEDS**

4 **ANALYSIS.**

5 Section 475 of the Higher Education Act of 1965 (20  
6 U.S.C. 1087oo) is amended by adding at the end the fol-  
7 lowing new subsection:

8 “(j) **ADJUSTMENTS FOR PARENTS OF ADOPTED**  
9 **CHILDREN.**—For parents of dependent students who are

1 adopted children, the expected family contribution is de-  
2 termined by—

3 “(1) dividing the expected family contribution  
4 determined under the other provisions of this section  
5 by 10; and

6 “(2) multiplying the resulting number by a  
7 number equal to the lesser of—

8 “(A) the number of complete years that  
9 such student has lived with such parents since  
10 being adopted; or

11 “(B) 10.”.
