- 3 SECTION 1. TREATMENT OF ADOPTED CHILDREN IN NEEDS
- 4 ANALYSIS.
- 5 Section 475 of the Higher Education Act of 1965 (20
- 6 U.S.C. 108700) is amended by adding at the end the fol-
- 7 lowing new subsection:
- 8 "(j) Adjustments for Parents of Adopted
- 9 Children.—For parents of dependent students who are

1	adopted children, the expected family contribution is de-
2	termined by—
3	"(1) dividing the expected family contribution
4	determined under the other provisions of this section
5	by 10; and
6	"(2) multiplying the resulting number by a
7	number equal to the lesser of—
8	"(A) the number of complete years that
9	such student has lived with such parents since
10	being adopted; or
11	"(B) 10.".
