To amend section 211 of the Clean Air Act to prohibit the use of the fuel additive MTBE in gasoline.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. USE OF MTBE AS A FUEL ADDITIVE.
- 4 (a) Amendment of Clean Air Act.—Section
- 5 211(c) of the Clean Air Act (42 U.S.C.7545(c)) is amend-
- 6 ed by adding at the end of paragraph (1) the following:
- 7 "The regulations under this paragraph shall prohibit the
- 8 use of methyl tertiary butyl ether (MTBE) as a fuel addi-
- 9 tive.".

- 1 (b) REGULATIONS.—The Administrator of the Envi-
- 2 ronmental Protection Agency shall amend the regulations
- 3 under section 211(c)(1) of the Clean Air Act as promptly
- 4 as practicable after the date of enactment of this Act to
- 5 conform to the amendment made by this Act.

6 SEC. 2. EFFECTIVE DATE.

- 7 Section 1 takes effect upon the expiration of the
- 8 three-year period beginning on the date of the enactment
- 9 of this Act.
