5 The Secretary of the Interior shall not expend any 6 funds for the preparation of, or conduct of, preleasing and 7 leasing activities (including calls for information, tract se-8 lection, notices of sale, receipt of bids, and award of 9 leases) with respect to an oil and gas lease sale on any lands of the outer Continental Shelf between the seaward
boundary between the States of Connecticut and Rhode
Island and the seaward boundary between the States of
North Carolina and South Carolina.
