Mr. BARTON of Texas (for himself and Mr. HALL of Texas) introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on Transportation and Infrastructure, and in addition to the Committee on Commerce, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned

A BILL

To authorize appropriations for carrying out pipeline safety activities under chapter 601 of title 49, United States Code.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.**

4 Section 60125 of title 49, United States Code, is
5 amended—

6 (1) by amending subsection (a) to read as fol-
7 lows:

1 “(a) GAS AND HAZARDOUS LIQUID.—To carry out
2 this chapter (except for sections 60107 and 60114(b)) re-
3 lated to gas and hazardous liquid, there are authorized
4 to be appropriated to the Department of Transportation—

5 “(1) \$21,442,000 for fiscal year 1999, of which
6 \$15,700,000 is to be derived from user fees for fis-
7 cal year 1999 collected under section 60301 of this
8 title;

9 “(2) \$22,194,000 for fiscal year 2000, of which
10 \$16,300,000 is to be derived from user fees for fis-
11 cal year 2000 collected under section 60301 of this
12 title;

13 “(3) \$22,900,000 for fiscal year 2001, of which
14 \$16,740,000 is to be derived from user fees for fis-
15 cal year 2001 collected under section 60301 of this
16 title; and

17 “(4) \$23,520,000 for fiscal year 2002, of which
18 \$17,200,000 is to be derived from user fees for fis-
19 cal year 2002 collected under section 60301 of this
20 title.”; and

21 (2) in subsection (c)(1)—

22 (A) by striking subparagraphs (A) through
23 (F);

1 (B) by redesignating subparagraphs (G)
2 and (H) as subparagraphs (A) and (B), respec-
3 tively; and

4 (C) by inserting at the end the following
5 new subparagraphs:

6 “(C) \$15,940,000 for fiscal year 2001, of which
7 \$14,070,000 is to be derived from user fees for fis-
8 cal year 2001 collected under section 60301 of this
9 title.

10 “(D) \$16,370,000 for fiscal year 2002, of which
11 \$14,450,000 is to be derived from user fees for fis-
12 cal year 2002 collected under section 60301 of this
13 title.”.
