A BILL

To make available funds for a security assistance training and support program for the self-defense of Kosova.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Kosova Self-Defense
- 5 Act of 1999".
- 6 SEC. 2. POLICY OF THE UNITED STATES.
- 7 It shall be the policy of the United States to provide
- 8 the interim government of Kosova with the capability to

- 1 defend and protect the civilian population of Kosova
- 2 against armed aggression.
- 3 SEC. 3. AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS FOR SECU-
- 4 RITY ASSISTANCE.
- 5 (a) Authorization of Appropriations.—In addi-
- 6 tion to funds otherwise available to carry out section 23
- 7 of the Arms Export Control Act (22 U.S.C. 2763), there
- 8 are authorized to be appropriated to the President to carry
- 9 out the provision of such section, \$25,000,000, which
- 10 amount shall be made available only for grants to the in-
- 11 terim government of Kosova to be used for training and
- 12 support for the established self-defense forces to carry out
- 13 the policy of section 2.
- 14 (b) Availability of Funds.—Amounts appro-
- 15 priated pursuant to subsection (a) are authorized to re-
- 16 main available until expended.
- 17 SEC. 4. RELATION TO EXISTING AUTHORITIES IN LAW.
- 18 Assistance provided under section 3 may be made
- 19 available notwithstanding any other provision of law
- 20 (including any executive order or directive or any rule or
- 21 regulation).
