- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-

- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Health Care Access
- 5 Promotion Act of 1999".

7	(a) In General.—Section 117(c) of the Internal
8	Revenue Code of 1986 (relating to the exclusion from

- 8 the application of the amendment made by subsection (a)
- 9 is prevented at any time before the close of the 1-year
- 10 period beginning on the date of the enactment of this Act
- 11 by the operation of any law or rule of law (including res
- 12 judicata), refund or credit of such overpayment (to the
- 13 extent attributable to the application of such amendment)
- 14 may, nevertheless, be made or allowed if claim therefor
- 15 is filed before the close of such 1-year period.

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
