A BILL

To require the Administrator of the Federal Aviation Administration to redesign expeditiously the airspace over the New Jersey/New York metropolitan area, and for other purposes.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Airspace Redesign En-
- 5 hancement Act of 1999".
- 6 SEC. 2. EXPEDITED REDESIGN OF CERTAIN AIRSPACE.
- 7 The Administrator of the Federal Aviation Adminis-
- 8 tration shall expeditiously redesign the airspace over the

- 1 New Jersey/New York metropolitan area, and shall com-
- 2 plete such redesign not later than the last day of the 2-
- 3 year period beginning on the date of enactment of this
- 4 Act.

5 SEC. 3. AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.

- 6 There shall be available to the Administrator of the
- 7 Federal Aviation Administration to carry out section 2 of
- 8 this Act, out of the Airport and Airway Trust Fund estab-
- 9 lished under section 9502 of the Internal Revenue Code
- 10 of 1986 (26 U.S.C. 9502), \$6,000,000 for each of fiscal
- 11 years 2000 and 2001.
