Mr. REYES introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on the Judiciary

A BILL

For the relief of Vince Munoz, Governor of the Tribal Council of the Ysleta del Sur Pueblo and all other enrolled members of the Ysleta del Sur Pueblo.

1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-

2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

3 That notwithstanding section 12 of the Act of August 13,
4 1946 (60 Stat. 1052), or any other statute of limitations,
5 the Secretary of the Treasury is authorized and directed
6 to pay, out of the Treasury from monies not otherwise
7 appropriated, to Vince Munoz, Governor the Tribal Coun8 cil of the Ysleta del Sur Pueblo, the sum of \$_____
9 for the benefit of and distribution to Vince Munoz and

10 all other enrolled members of the Ysleta del Sur Pueblo.

The payment of said sum shall be in full settlement of 1 all claims of the Ysleta del Sur Pueblo arising from the 2 taking by the United States of land owned or occupied 3 by the Ysleta del Sur Pueblo without payment for such 4 5 lands of compensation agreed to by that tribe, and claims based upon fair and honorable dealings that are not recog-6 nized by any existing rule of law or equity, and other 7 claims which otherwise, except for the lapse of time and 8 the failure to timely file, would have been compensable 9 under the Act of August 13, 1946 (60 Stat. 1049). 10

0
