- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-

- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Pregnancy Discrimina-
- 5 tion Act Amendments of 1999".
- 6 SEC. 2. AMENDMENT TO TITLE VII OF THE CIVIL RIGHTS
- 7 ACT OF 1964.
- 8 Section 701(k) of the Civil Rights Act of 1964 (42)
- 9 U.S.C. 2000e(k)) is amended—

1	(1) by inserting	"breastfeeding,"	after	"child-
2	birth", and			

(2) by adding at the end the following: "For purposes of this subsection, the term 'breastfeeding' means the feeding of a child directly from the breast or the expression of milk from the breast by a lactating woman.".
