- 3 SECTION 1. REPLACEMENT OF CERTAIN COASTAL BAR-
- 4 RIER RESOURCES SYSTEM MAPS.
- 5 (a) In General.—The 7 maps subtitled "NC-03P",
- 6 relating to the Coastal Barrier Resources System units
- 7 designated as Cape Hatteras 5A through 5G, that are in-
- 8 cluded in the set of maps entitled "Coastal Barrier Re-
- 9 source System" and referred to in section 4(a) of the
- 10 Coastal Barrier Resources Act (16 U.S.C. 3503(a)), are

- 1 hereby replaced by 7 other maps relating to those units
- 2 entitled "Coastal Barrier Resources System, NC-03P"
- 3 and dated \_\_\_\_\_\_.
- 4 (b) AVAILABILITY.—The Secretary of the Interior
- 5 shall keep the maps referred to in subsection (a) on file
- 6 and available for inspection in accordance with the provi-
- 7 sions of section 4(b) of the Coastal Barrier Resources Act
- 8 (16 U.S.C. 3503(b)).
