A BILL

To clarify boundaries on maps related to the Coastal Barrier Resources System.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. REPLACEMENT OF CERTAIN COASTAL BAR-**
4 **RIER RESOURCES SYSTEM MAPS.**

5 (a) IN GENERAL.—The 7 maps subtitled “NC–03P”,
6 relating to the Coastal Barrier Resources System units
7 designated as Cape Hatteras 5A through 5G, that are in-
8 cluded in the set of maps entitled “Coastal Barrier Re-
9 source System” and referred to in section 4(a) of the
10 Coastal Barrier Resources Act (16 U.S.C. 3503(a)), are

1 hereby replaced by 7 other maps relating to those units
2 entitled “Coastal Barrier Resources System, NC-03P”
3 and dated _____.

4 (b) AVAILABILITY.—The Secretary of the Interior
5 shall keep the maps referred to in subsection (a) on file
6 and available for inspection in accordance with the provi-
7 sions of section 4(b) of the Coastal Barrier Resources Act
8 (16 U.S.C. 3503(b)).
