3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “America's Agricultural
5 Heritage Partnership Amendments of 1999”.

1 **SEC. 2. PARTICIPATION OF THE SECRETARY OF THE INTE-**
2 **RIOR.**

3 (a) **ROLE OF THE SECRETARY.**—Section 702(5) of
4 the Omnibus Parks and Public Lands Management Act
5 of 1996 (division II of the Public Law 104–333; 110 Stat.
6 4265) is amended by striking “Secretary of Agriculture”
7 and inserting “Secretary of the Interior”.

8 (b) **EFFECT ON APPROVAL OF PARTNERSHIP MAN-**
9 **AGEMENT PLAN.**—The amendment made by subsection
10 (a) shall not affect the approval or continued vitality of
11 the management plan that was prepared for establishment
12 of the America’s Agricultural Heritage Partnership, which
13 was approved by the Secretary of Agriculture on July 8,
14 1998, by publication of a notice of approval in the Federal
15 Register of July 15, 1998 (63 Fed. Reg. 38147).
