A BILL

For the relief of Jean-Loup J. M. Chrétien.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. WAIVER OF CERTAIN NATURALIZATION RE-**
4 **QUIREMENTS FOR JEAN-LOUP J. M.**
5 **CHRÉTIEN.**

6 (a) IN GENERAL.—Notwithstanding his inability to
7 meet the requirements of section 319(a) of the Immigra-
8 tion and Nationality Act relating to residence and physical
9 presence in the United States, Jean-Loup J. M. Chrétien
10 shall be deemed eligible for naturalization upon the filing
11 of the appropriate application, if otherwise qualified for
12 naturalization under such Act.

1 (b) DEADLINE FOR APPLICATION AND PAYMENT OF
2 FEES.—Subsection (a) shall apply only if the application
3 for naturalization is filed with appropriate fees within 2
4 years after the date of the enactment of this Act.
