## A BILL

To amend the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 to make permanent law the \$5,000 first-time homebuyer credit for the District of Columbia.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3       **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4       This Act may be cited as the “District of Columbia  
5       \$5,000 Homebuyer Credit Act of 1999”.

6       **SEC. 2. FIRST-TIME HOMEBUYER CREDIT FOR DISTRICT OF**  
7       **COLUMBIA MADE PERMANENT.**

8       Subsection (i) of section 1400C of the Internal Rev-  
9       enue Code of 1986 (relating to first-time homebuyer credit

1 for District of Columbia) is amended by striking “, and  
2 before January 1, 2001”.
