## A BILL

To amend part Q of title I of the Omnibus Crime Control and Safe Streets Act of 1965 to prevent motorist stops motivated by race or other bias.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3       **SECTION 1. FAIRNESS IN MOTOR STOPS.**

4       Section 1702(d) of title I of the Omnibus Crime Con-  
5       trol and Safe Streets Act of 1968 is amended by adding  
6       at the end the following:

7               “(3)   ADDITIONAL   ELIGIBILITY   REQUIRE-  
8       MENT.—In conjunction with the application sub-  
9       mitted under this section, an applicant for a grant  
10      shall provide assurances to the Attorney General

1       that the applicant has adopted, implemented, and is  
2       enforcing a policy that prohibits motorist stops moti-  
3       vated by race or other bias.”.
