A BILL

To direct the Secretary of the Interior to study the suitability and feasibility of including the Gaviota Coast of California in the National Park System.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Gaviota Coast Act of
5 1999”.

6 **SEC. 2. GAVIOTA COAST.**

7 (a) STUDY REQUIREMENT.—The Secretary of the In-
8 terior shall conduct a study, pursuant to the criteria set
9 forth in section 8(c)(2) of Public Law 91–383 (16 U.S.C.
10 1a–5(c)(2); commonly known as the National Park Sys-

1 tem General Authorities Act), of the suitability and feasi-
2 bility of including the area of California known as the
3 Gaviota Coast in the National Park System. The study
4 area shall extend generally from Coal Oil Point at Santa
5 Barbara to Point Sal, California.

6 (b) SUBMISSION.—The Secretary shall submit the
7 findings of such study upon its completion to the Com-
8 mittee on Resources of the House of Representatives and
9 the Committee on Energy and Natural Resources of the
10 Senate.
