## A BILL

To suspend temporarily the duty on certain polyethylene  
base materials.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3       **SECTION 1. SUSPENSION OF DUTY ON CERTAIN POLY-**  
4       **ETHYLENE BASE MATERIALS.**

5       (a) IN GENERAL.—Subchapter II of chapter 99 of  
6       the Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the United States is  
7       amended by inserting in numerical sequence the following  
8       new heading:

“	9902.39.20	Polyethylene base materials that are under 250mm in width, sanded on 1 side and surface-treat- ed for use in the manufac- ture of skis (provided for in subheading 3920.10.00) ..	Free	No change	No change	On or before 12/31/2001	”.

1           (b) APPLICABILITY.—The amendment made by this  
 2 section applies to goods entered, or withdrawn from ware-  
 3 house for consumption, on or after the 15th day after the  
 4 date of the enactment of this Act.
