A BILL

To amend title 18, United States Code, to ban using the Internet to obtain or dispose of a firearm.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. BAN ON USING THE INTERNET TO OBTAIN OR
- 4 DISPOSE OF A FIREARM.
- 5 (a) Prohibitions.—Section 922 of title 18, United
- 6 States Code, is amended by inserting after subsection (y)
- 7 the following:
- 8 "(z) It shall be unlawful for any person to use the
- 9 Internet to obtain or dispose of, or offer to obtain or dis-
- 10 pose of a firearm.".

- 1 (b) Penalties.—Section 924(a) of title 18, United
- 2 States Code, is amended by adding at the end the fol-
- 3 lowing:
- 4 "(7) Whoever willfully violates section 922(z)
- 5 shall be fined under this title, imprisoned not more
- 6 than 1 year, or both.".
