2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. NATIONAL GUARD YOUTH CHALLENGE PRO-**
4 **GRAM.**

5 (a) FISCAL YEAR 2000 AUTHORITY.—Notwith-
6 standing the expenditure limitation contained in sub-
7 section (b) of section 509 of title 32, United States Code,
8 the Secretary of Defense may obligate funds during fiscal

1 year 2000 in an amount not to exceed \$110,000,000 for
2 the National Guard civilian youth opportunities program
3 authorized by that section and known as the National
4 Guard Challenge Program.

5 (b) ELIMINATION OF ANNUAL EXPENDITURE LIM-
6 TATION.—Section 509(b) of title 32, United States Code,
7 is amended by striking out “, except that Federal expendi-
8 tures under the program may not exceed \$50,000,000 for
9 any fiscal year”.
