3 SECTION 1. NATIONAL GUARD YOUTH CHALLENGE PRO-4 GRAM.

5 (a) FISCAL YEAR 2000 AUTHORITY.—Notwith6 standing the expenditure limitation contained in sub7 section (b) of section 509 of title 32, United States Code,
8 the Secretary of Defense may obligate funds during fiscal

year 2000 in an amount not to exceed \$110,000,000 for
 the National Guard civilian youth opportunities program
 authorized by that section and known as the National
 Guard Challenge Program.

5 (b) ELIMINATION OF ANNUAL EXPENDITURE LIMI6 TATION.—Section 509(b) of title 32, United States Code,
7 is amended by striking out ", except that Federal expendi8 tures under the program may not exceed \$50,000,000 for
9 any fiscal year".
