- 2 the National Guard civilian youth opportunities program
- 3 authorized by that section and known as the National
- 4 Guard Challenge Program.
- 5 (b) Elimination of Annual Expenditure Limi-
- 6 TATION.—Section 509(b) of title 32, United States Code,
- 7 is amended by striking out ", except that Federal expendi-
- 8 tures under the program may not exceed \$50,000,000 for
- 9 any fiscal year".
