1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the United States of America in Congress assembled, 2 3 SECTION 1. PROHIBITION ON RECONSTRUCTION ASSIST-4 ANCE FOR THE FEDERAL REPUBLIC OF 5 YUGOSLAVIA (SERBIA AND MONTENEGRO). 6 (a) PROHIBITION.—No funds appropriated or other-7 wise made available in any Act (for any fiscal year) may 8 be obligated or expended for the provision of reconstruc-9 tion assistance for the Federal Republic of Yugoslavia

(Serbia and Montenegro) as a result of Operation Allied
 Force.

3 (b) OPERATION ALLIED FORCE.—In this section, the
4 term "Operation Allied Force" means operations of the
5 North Atlantic Treaty Organization (NATO) conducted
6 against the Federal Republic of Yugoslavia (Serbia and
7 Montenegro) during the period beginning on March 24,
8 1999, and ending on such date as NATO may designate,
9 to resolve the conflict with respect to Kosovo.
