admission engages in terrorist activity (as defined in section 212(a)(3)(B)(iii)) is deportable.

"(ii) Association with known ter-RORISTS.—Any alien who at any time after admission associates with an individual who the alien knows, or has reasonable ground to believe, is designated as a terrorist in the Department of State publication entitled 'Patterns of Global Terrorism' is deportable. For the purposes of the preceding sentence, an alien shall be considered to have associated with such an individual if the alien engaged in a pattern of conduct that, with respect to both the frequency and the nature of the conduct, gives rise to a reasonable suspicion that the alien knowingly aided and abetted such an individual to engage in terrorist activity (as defined in section 212(a)(3)(B)(iii)).".
