## A BILL

To amend the Immigration and Nationality Act to provide  
for the removal of aliens who associate with known terrorists.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3       **SECTION 1. REMOVAL OF ALIENS WHO ASSOCIATE WITH**  
4       **KNOWN TERRORISTS.**

5       Section 237(a)(4)(B) of the Immigration and Nation-  
6       ality Act (8 U.S.C. 1227(a)(4)(B)) is amended to read as  
7       follows:

8               “(B) TERRORIST ACTIVITIES.—

9               “(i) IN GENERAL.—Any alien who has  
10              engaged, is engaged, or at any time after

1 admission engages in terrorist activity (as  
2 defined in section 212(a)(3)(B)(iii)) is de-  
3 portable.

4 “(ii) ASSOCIATION WITH KNOWN TER-  
5 RORISTS.—Any alien who at any time after  
6 admission associates with an individual  
7 who the alien knows, or has reasonable  
8 ground to believe, is designated as a ter-  
9 rorist in the Department of State publica-  
10 tion entitled ‘Patterns of Global Terrorism’  
11 is deportable. For the purposes of the pre-  
12 ceding sentence, an alien shall be consid-  
13 ered to have associated with such an indi-  
14 vidual if the alien engaged in a pattern of  
15 conduct that, with respect to both the fre-  
16 quency and the nature of the conduct,  
17 gives rise to a reasonable suspicion that  
18 the alien knowingly aided and abetted such  
19 an individual to engage in terrorist activity  
20 (as defined in section 212(a)(3)(B)(iii)).”.
