4	SEC. 3. SENTENCING COMMISSION GUIDELINES.
5	Section 2(g) of the No Electronic Theft (NET) Act (28
6	U.S.C. 994 note) is amended by striking paragraph (2) and
7	inserting the following:
8	"(2) In implementing paragraph (1), the Sentencing
9	Commission shall amend the guideline applicable to crimi-
10	nal infringement of a copyright or trademark to provide
11	an enhancement based upon the retail price of the legiti-
12	mate items that are infringed upon and the quantity of the
13	infringing items. To the extent the conduct involves a viola-
14	tion of section 2319A of title 18, United States Code, the
15	enhancement shall be based upon the retail price of the in-
16	fringing items and the quantity of the infringing items.
