1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled, 3 That, notwithstanding chapter 475 of title 49, United 4 States Code, and any other provision of law, the sponsor 5 of the Burbank-Glendale-Pasadena Airport in California 6 may impose noise restrictions on operations (including 7 curfews and limits on the number of daily take-offs and
