6	(a) In General.—Subparagraph (G) of section
7	114(b)(1) of title 4, United States Code (relating to limi-
8	tation on State income taxation of certain pension in-
9	come), is amended by striking "of such Code" and insert-
10	ing "of such Code, determined by treating the Common-
11	wealth of Puerto Rico as a State".
12	(b) Effective Date.—The amendment made by
13	subsection (a) shall apply to amounts received after the
14	date of the enactment of this Act.

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
