- 1 (b) Taxes and Fees Not To Apply.—The articles
- 2 described in heading 9902.98.08 of the Harmonized Tariff
- 3 Schedule of the United States (as added by subsection (a))
- 4 shall be free of taxes and fees which may be otherwise
- 5 applicable.
- 6 (c) No Exemption From Customs Inspections.—
- 7 The articles described in heading 9902.98.08 of the Har-
- 8 monized Tariff Schedule of the United States (as added
- 9 by subsection (a)) shall not be free or otherwise exempt
- 10 or excluded from routine or other inspections as may be
- 11 required by the Customs Service.
- 12 (d) Effective Date.—The amendment made by
- 13 this section applies to articles entered, or withdrawn from
- 14 warehouse for consumption, on or after the date of enact-
- 15 ment of this Act.
