Mr. PORTER introduced the following bill; which was referred to the  
Committee on the Judiciary

## A BILL

For the relief of Edwardo Reyes and Danelita Reyes.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3       **SECTION 1. PERMANENT RESIDENT STATUS FOR EDUARDO**  
4       **REYES AND DIANELITA REYES.**

5       (a) IN GENERAL.—Notwithstanding subsections (a)  
6       and (b) of section 201 of the Immigration and Nationality  
7       Act, Edwardo Reyes and Danelita Reyes shall be eligible  
8       for issuance of an immigrant visa or for adjustment of  
9       status to that of an alien lawfully admitted for permanent  
10      residence upon filing an application for issuance of an im-  
11      migrant visa under section 204 of such Act or for adjust-  
12      ment of status to lawful permanent resident.

1       (b) ADJUSTMENT OF STATUS.—If Edwardo Reyes or  
2 Danelita Reyes enters the United States before the filing  
3 deadline specified in subsection (c), he or she shall be con-  
4 sidered to have entered and remained lawfully and shall,  
5 if otherwise eligible, be eligible for adjustment of status  
6 under section 245 of the Immigration and Nationality Act  
7 as of the date of the enactment of this Act.

8       (c) DEADLINE FOR APPLICATION AND PAYMENT OF  
9 FEES.—Subsections (a) and (b) shall apply only if the ap-  
10 plication for issuance of an immigrant visa or the applica-  
11 tion for adjustment of status is filed with appropriate fees  
12 within 2 years after the date of the enactment of this Act.

13       (d) REDUCTION OF IMMIGRANT VISA NUMBER.—  
14 Upon the granting of an immigrant visa or permanent res-  
15 idence to Edwardo Reyes and Danelita Reyes, the Sec-  
16 retary of State shall instruct the proper officer to reduce  
17 by 2, during the current or next following fiscal year, the  
18 total number of immigrant visas that are made available  
19 to natives of the country of the aliens' birth under section  
20 203(a) of the Immigration and Nationality Act or, if appli-  
21 cable, the total number of immigrant visas that are made  
22 available to natives of the country of the aliens' birth  
23 under section 202(e) of such Act.

24       (e) DENIAL OF PREFERENTIAL IMMIGRATION  
25 TREATMENT FOR CERTAIN RELATIVES.—The natural

1 parents, brothers, and sisters of Edwardo Reyes and  
2 Dianelita Reyes shall not, by virtue of such relationship,  
3 be accorded any right, privilege, or status under the Immi-  
4 gration and Nationality Act.
