- 3 That section 2511 of title 18, United States Code, is
- 4 amended by adding at the end the following:
- 5 "(6) If an officer or employee of the Federal Govern-
- 6 ment, acting under color of that office or employment,
- 7 commits an offense under this section, such officer or em-
- 8 ployee shall be sentenced to not less than 6 months impris-

- 1 onment and may be sentenced up to the maximum other-
- 2 wise provided by law.".
