A BILL

To amend title 18, United States Code, to provide a mandatory minimum prison sentence for certain wiretapping or electronic surveillance offenses by Federal officers or employees.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 That section 2511 of title 18, United States Code, is
4 amended by adding at the end the following:

5 “(6) If an officer or employee of the Federal Govern-
6 ment, acting under color of that office or employment,
7 commits an offense under this section, such officer or em-
8 ployee shall be sentenced to not less than 6 months impris-

- 1 onment and may be sentenced up to the maximum other-
- 2 wise provided by law.”.
