A BILL

For the relief of Abimbola Oyebade-Balogun.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. CONSENT TO TRAVEL ABROAD FOR ABIMBOLA
- 4 **OYEBADE-BALOGUN.**
- 5 The Attorney General shall authorize Abimbola
- 6 Oyebade-Balogun temporarily to travel abroad to Lagos,
- 7 Nigeria, because of emergency and extenuating cir-
- 8 cumstances. If Abimbola Oyebade-Balogun returns to the
- 9 United States at the conclusion of this temporary trip
- 10 abroad, she shall be inspected and admitted in the same
- 11 immigration status she had at the time of departure.
