A BILL

For the relief of Abimbola Oyebade-Balogun.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. CONSENT TO TRAVEL ABROAD FOR ABIMBOLA**
4 **OYEBADE-BALOGUN.**

5 The Attorney General shall authorize Abimbola
6 Oyebade-Balogun temporarily to travel abroad to Lagos,
7 Nigeria, because of emergency and extenuating cir-
8 cumstances. If Abimbola Oyebade-Balogun returns to the
9 United States at the conclusion of this temporary trip
10 abroad, she shall be inspected and admitted in the same
11 immigration status she had at the time of departure.
