- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Temporary Tax Termi-
- 5 nation Act of 1999".
- 6 SEC. 2. REPEAL OF TEMPORARY UNEMPLOYMENT TAX.
- 7 Section 3301 of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986
- 8 (relating to rate of unemployment tax) is amended—
- 9 (1) by striking "2007" in paragraph (1) and in-
- 10 serting "1999"; and

- 1 (2) by striking "2008" in paragraph (2) and in-
- 2 serting "2000".
