3 SECTION 1. EXTENSION OF WORK OPPORTUNITY CREDIT 4 AND WELFARE-TO-WORK CREDIT.

(a) WORK OPPORTUNITY CREDIT.—Subparagraph
(B) of section 51(c)(4) of the Internal Revenue Code of
1986 (relating to termination) is amended by striking
"June 30, 1999" and inserting "June 30, 2004".

9 (b) WELFARE-TO-WORK CREDIT.—Subparagraph (f)
10 of section 51A of such Code (relating to temporary incen-

tives for employing long-term family assistance recipients)
 is amended by striking "June 30, 1999" and inserting
 "June 30, 2004".

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
