8 “June 30, 1999” and inserting “June 30, 2004”.

9 (b) WELFARE-TO-WORK CREDIT.—Subparagraph (f)
10 of section 51A of such Code (relating to temporary incen-

- 2 is amended by striking “June 30, 1999” and inserting
- 3 “June 30, 2004”.
